

# IMPORTANT UPDATE

**Merck is extending its emergency prescription replacement program through October 15.**

**If you have lost any Merck prescriptions due to Hurricane Katrina or Hurricane Rita, we may be able to help you and your pharmacist replace them free.** If you filled your prescription at a U.S. retail pharmacy, simply go to one of their store locations by October 15, 2005, and they will be able to refill your prescription at no charge (for list of medicines see other side). To take advantage of this program, please check with your nearest pharmacy to find out if they are participating.

**If you need help getting Merck medicines after October 15, 2005,** you may be eligible for the Merck Patient Assistance Program. To find out if this program is right for you, call 1-800-727-5400.
