

Merck plans to invest \$16 billion in capital projects over the next five years, including more than \$9 billion in the U.S., to meet growing demand for Merck's medicines and vaccines and enable Merck to stay at the cutting edge of research.

These investments include expansion of many existing plants and sites in the U.S., construction of a formulation lab and experimentation center at our Rahway, NJ research site, and construction of new discovery research sites in South San Francisco, California, and London, UK.



25,000 EMPLOYEES

Merck has more employees in the U.S. than we have in any other country: 25,000 full-time employees in highly-skilled jobs that pay well and generate growth for the U.S. economy.



\$60 BILLION

Since 2010, Merck has invested more than \$60B into R&D, most of it in the U.S.

Merck is among the top investors in R&D, spending more than \$7B in 2017 alone.
