ELOCON® (El-oh-con)
(mometasone furoate) Cream, 0.1%

Important information: ELOCON Cream is for use on skin only. Do not use ELOCON Cream in your eyes, mouth, or vagina.

What is ELOCON Cream?

- ELOCON Cream is a prescription medicine used on the skin (topical) for the relief of redness, swelling, heat, pain (inflammation) and itching, caused by certain skin problems in people 2 years of age and older.
 - It is not known if ELOCON Cream is safe and effective for use in children under 2 years of age.
 - ELOCON cream should not be used in children under 2 years of age.
 - It is not known if ELOCON Cream is safe and effective for use in children longer than 3 weeks.

Do not use ELOCON Cream if you are allergic to mometasone furoate or any of the ingredients in ELOCON Cream. See the end of this leaflet for a complete list of ingredients in ELOCON Cream.

Before using ELOCON Cream, tell your healthcare provider about all your medical conditions, including if you:

- have a skin infection at the site to be treated. You may also need medicine to treat the skin infection.
- are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. It is not known if ELOCON Cream will harm your unborn baby.
- are breastfeeding or plan to breastfeed. It is not known if ELOCON Cream passes into your breast milk.

Tell your healthcare provider about all the medicines you take, including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements.

Especially tell your healthcare provider if you take other corticosteroid medicines by mouth or use other products on your skin or scalp that contain corticosteroids.

How should I use ELOCON Cream?

- Use ELOCON Cream exactly as your healthcare provider tells you to use it.
- Apply a thin film of ELOCON Cream to the affected skin area 1 time each day.
- Tell your healthcare provider if the treated skin area does not get better after 2 weeks of treatment.
- Do not bandage, cover, or wrap the treated skin area unless your healthcare provider tells you to.
- ELOCON Cream should not be used to treat diaper rash or redness. Do not apply ELOCON Cream in the diaper area if wearing diapers or plastic pants.
- Avoid using ELOCON Cream on the face, groin, or underarms (armpits).
- Wash your hands after applying ELOCON Cream.

What are the possible side effects of ELOCON Cream?

ELOCON Cream may cause serious side effects, including:

- **ELOCON Cream can pass through your skin.** Too much ELOCON Cream passing through your skin can cause your adrenal glands to stop working properly. Your healthcare provider may do blood tests to check for adrenal gland problems.
- **Vision problems.** Topical corticosteroids may increase your chance of developing vision problems such as cataract and glaucoma. Tell your healthcare provider if you develop blurred vision or other vision problems during treatment with ELOCON Cream.
- **Skin problems.** Skin problems may happen during treatment with ELOCON Cream, including allergic reactions (contact dermatitis) and skin infections at the treatment site. Stop using ELOCON Cream and tell your healthcare provider if you develop any skin reactions such as pain, tenderness, swelling, or problems healing during treatment with ELOCON Cream.

The most common side effects of ELOCON Cream include burning, itching, and thinning of the skin (atrophy).

These are not all the possible side effects of ELOCON Cream.

How should I store ELOCON Cream?

- Store ELOCON Cream at room temperature between 68°F to 77°F (20°C to 25°C).
- **Keep ELOCON Cream and all medicines out of the reach of children.**

General information about the safe and effective use of ELOCON Cream.

Medicines are sometimes prescribed for purposes other than those listed in a Patient Information leaflet. Do not use


ELOCON Cream for a condition for which it was not prescribed. Do not give ELOCON Cream to other people, even if they have the same symptoms that you have. It may harm them. You can ask your pharmacist or healthcare provider for information about ELOCON Cream that is written for health professionals.

What are the ingredients in ELOCON Cream?

Active ingredient: mometasone furoate

Inactive ingredients: aluminum starch octenylsuccinate (Gamma Irradiated), hexylene glycol, hydrogenated soybean lecithin, phosphoric acid, purified water, titanium dioxide, white soft paraffin, and white wax
